



#### **Digital Banking**

93% of HK consumers and 57% of those in Mainland China have experienced digital banking services via Internet Banking or Smartphone\*; the use of mobile technology is rising.

#### **Growth of Financial Technology (FinTech)**

Financial technology, also known as FinTech, is about fostering innovation in financial services using technology. Impact on the banking sector – change the way how financial services are provided and consumed covering payments; lending and capital raising; and advisory services.



#### Growing demand for wealth management products and services

Hong Kong is the largest asset management centre in Asia. In 2012, assets management business of licensed corporations, registered institutions and insurance companies amounted to USD 1,064 billion and the assets under management under private banking amounted to an additional USD 346 billion.




