

The Education System of British Columbia










Thriving research culture

Applied research at colleges and institutes

Colleges, institutes and polytechnics undertake applied research in collaboration with small and medium-sized enterprises to create, refine or adapt products, services, technologies, and process.

International students can participate in applied research opportunities and gain relevant practical experience.

Student entrepreneurs have access to research labs, incubators, and entrepreneurship accelerators.

Vocational training

Focus on learning **skills** to meet future employer needs

- Work while you study
- •High job placement rate (70-90%)
- Opportunity for family, spouses and children

Québec métiers d'avenir has been commissioned by Quebec's Ministry of Education and Quebec institutions to provide you with administration and immigration support for vocational training.

Training at Quebec vocational centres:

- Is recognized in the Quebec job market
- Is short term (one to two years)
- •Is in French or English
- •Is practical (80% technical 20% theoretical)
- Uses state-of-the-art facilities
- Is tuition fee exempt for French nationals
- Is world renowned

Post-Graduate Workers Permit Program (PGWPP)

Canada's Post-Graduation Work Permit Program allows students who have graduated from eligible Canadian designated learning institutions (DLIs) to obtain work experience.

This opportunity for work experience can help graduates qualify for permanent residency (PR).

Points to Note: Application for Post-Secondary Education

- Colleges Study all year: programs offered in fall, winter, spring and summer
- Most universities will open admission in October and close in January–April (CHECK each program for accurate deadlines)
- Submit official academic transcripts, language test scores and personal profile (if applicable)
- Acceptance is based on academic merit
