The **CLAP Portfolio *Infinity*** is developed with the aim to encourage young people to set their life and career goals and to identify actions to implement them. *Portfolio Infinity* is an online tool with functions to help students and youths to record and reflect upon their past present, and future experiences, including interests, values, accomplishments and their ‘shinning points,’ and to “connect the dots” toward construction and designing their career and life future. Through this launch and good-practice sharing, we invite all the secondary schools to use *Portfolio Infinity* to support the career development of students.

**CLAP Career Development Curriculum** is an integral part of *Portfolio Infinity*. The CLAP career development curriculum aims to equip secondary students with the necessary attitudes, knowledge, and competence to engage in a career and life planning journey. In this event we will share the design and content of the CLAP career development curriculum, as well as how schools could use and implement the curriculum.

In addition to sharing the conceptual and design principles of *Portfolio Infinity* and the different functions, the Project Team has also invited several teachers and students from CLAP Network Schools who have tried out *Portfolio Infinity* to share their experience. 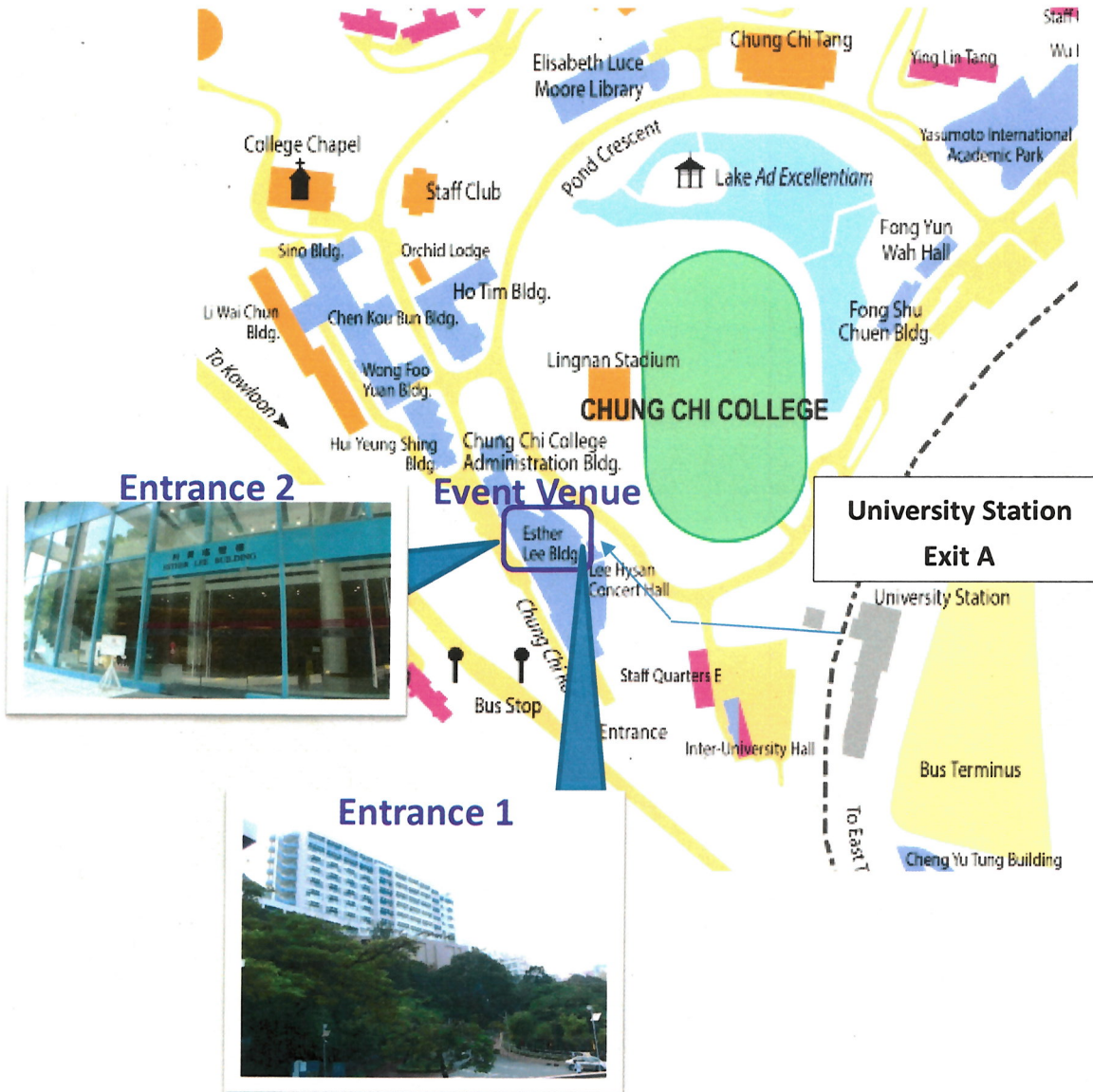
